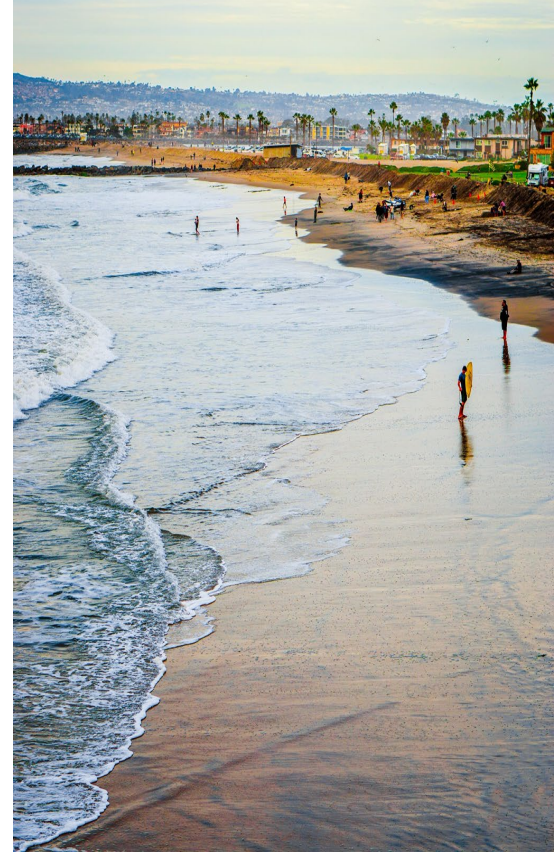


Sustaining Regional Impact

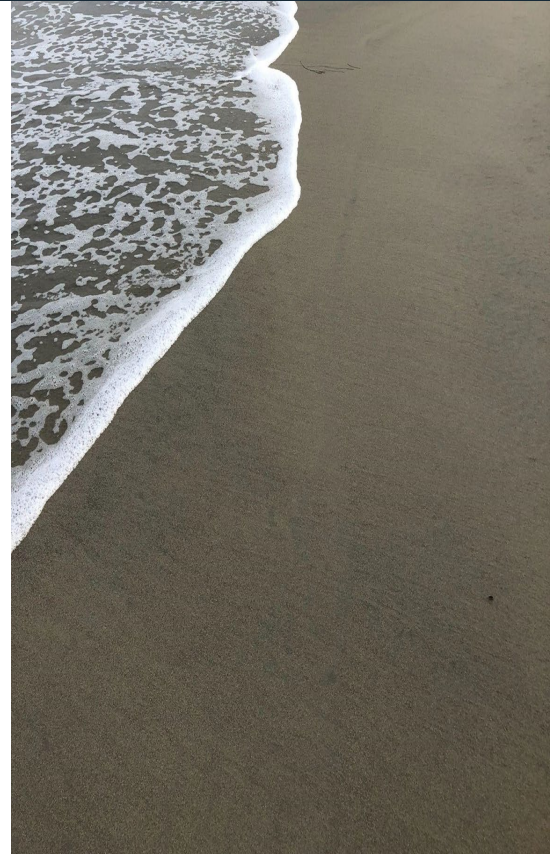

Establishing a San Diego Regional Coastal Resilience Roadmap



This project will develop a Coastal Resilience Roadmap to identify, mobilize, and accelerate equitable projects and investments in the San Diego region, as well as to build overall capacity that builds coastal resilience regionally.



Contextualizing: First, we collect data to see how the region perceives coastal resilience



Feedback: Using our network, we have conversations with stakeholders about coastal resilience—what are the gaps in knowledge and opportunities have potential?



Development: How can we synthesize our findings with our feedback to create a new tool?



Documentation: Put our findings and developed resources into one place

Actions Database

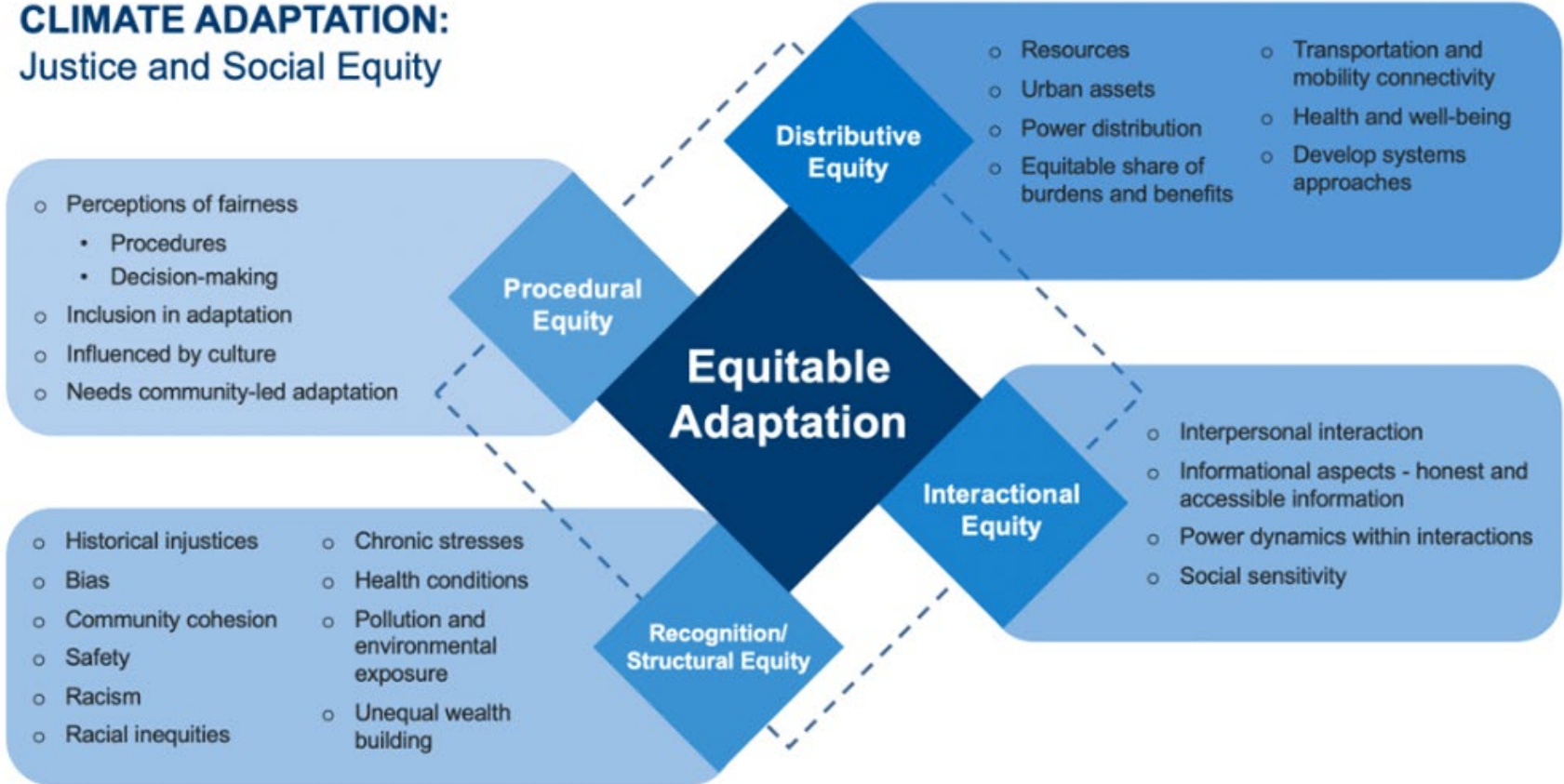
